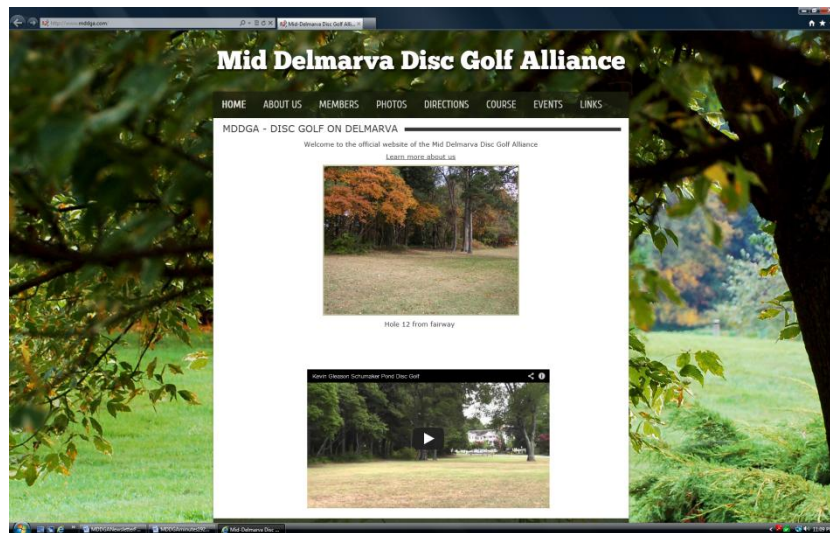
Course Workdays
